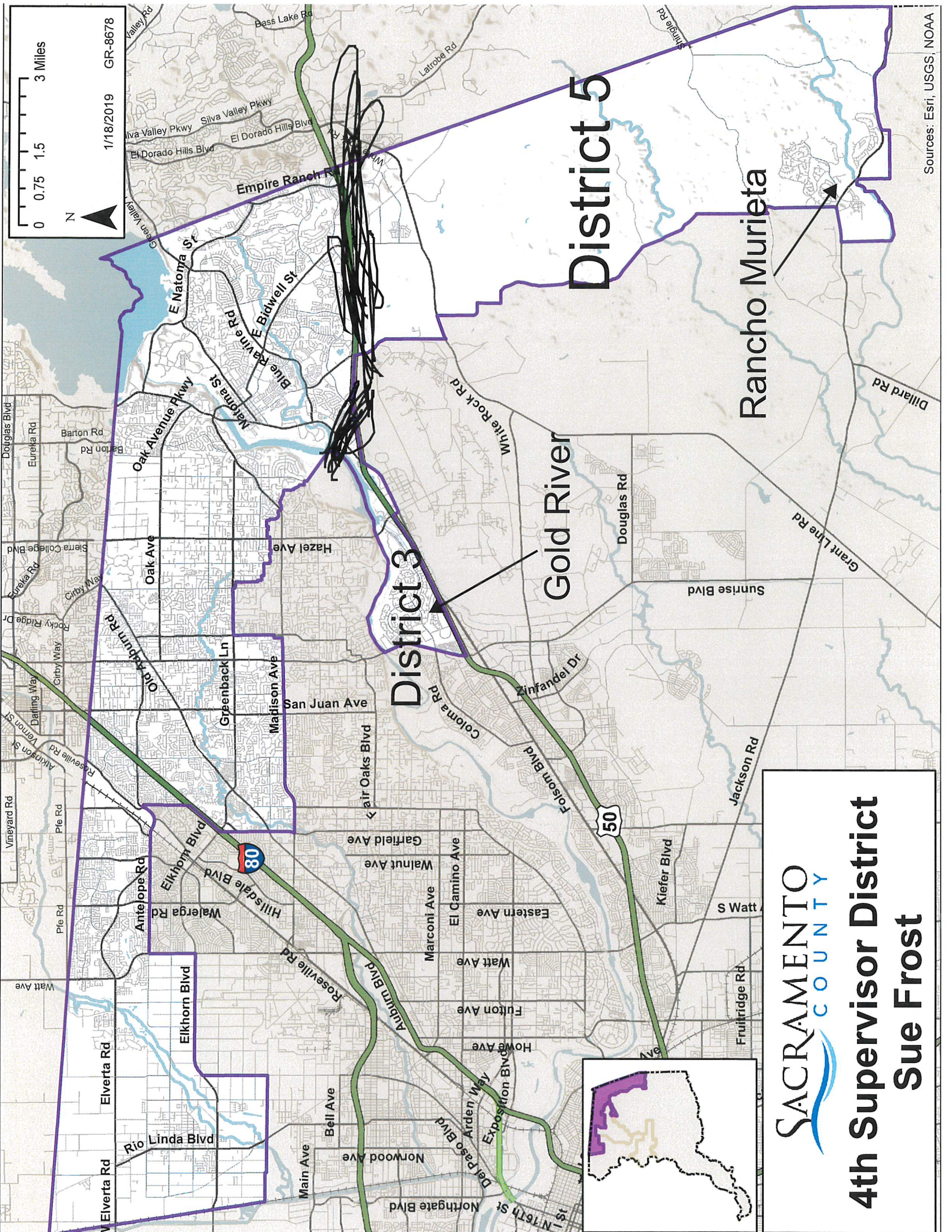
Hello,

My name is Quetzal Cornejo and I'm a resident of District 2. I happened upon the District maps and couldn't help but stare at the monstrosity that is District 4. It not only contains the city of Folsom which is one of the wealthiest cities in our county but it seems intentionally drawn so as to include two other areas of uncharacteristically high-income. These are Rancho Murieta and Gold River, two county areas with a median income above \$100,000, a figure far higher than the median income of Sacramento County which stands at \$67,000. It is impossible to dismiss that high-incomes are correlated to conservative values which are not popular within Sacramento County but nevertheless have a voice in Sue Frost, the most conservative member of the Board of Supervisors. This seems like a clear case of gerrymandering.

To fix this issue we can draw Rancho Murieta, which has a population of less than 6,000 people, to be within District 5 for consistency. Gold River should be drawn within District 3 to be consistent with the rest of the district, which includes mostly areas South of the city of Citrus Heights and North of Highway US-50. The edges of Districts 3, 4, and 5 are adjusted accordingly so that populations are equal across districts. Please see the attached PDF for a sample map.
