HEARING DATE: NOVEMBER 16, 2021 at 6:00 PM HEARING LOCATION: Sacramento County Administration Building Board of Supervisor Chambers 700 H Street, Room 1450 Sacramento, CA 95814 PUBLIC COMMENT PROCEDURES In compliance with directives of the County, State, and Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), the meeting will be live stream and open to public attendance pursuant to guidelines related to social distancing and minimizing person-to-person contact. IN-PERSON PUBLIC COMMENT Members of the public may address the Board in-person to make a public comment. A facemask and social distancing are required while inside the County Administration Building and Board Chambers. Seating is limited and available on a first-come, first-served basis. Members of the public addressing the Board will be required to complete and submit a speaker request form to Clerk staff. The Chairperson will invite each individual to the podium to make a verbal comment during the public comment period for each agenda item or off-agenda matter. TELEPHONIC PUBLIC COMMENT On the day of the meeting dial (916) 875-2500 to make a verbal public comment (follow the prompts for instructions). Refer to the agenda and listen to the live meeting to determine when is the best time to call to be placed in queue for a specific agenda item. Callers may be on hold for up to an extended period of time and should plan accordingly. When the Chairperson opens public comment for a specific agenda item or off-agenda matter, callers will be transferred from the queue into the meeting to make a verbal comment. 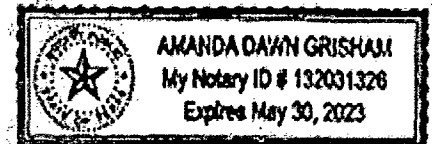
